**PLEASE READ THIS APPLICATION CAREFULLY AND PROOFREAD IT BEFORE TURNING IT IN. AN INCOMPLETE APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

In order to be a member of the Leadership Class, you should be identified as a leader (by your parents, teachers, and peers), be a great positive role model for other students, love being involved in student activities, and be willing to commit your time (**before, during, and after school** to improving schoolwide activities.) You must have an exemplary student behavior record, and maintain a 2.5 gpa with no F's in order to maintain your position. These things are a MUST. If you agree to be a member of the Student Leadership Group at SMS, you will be required (as part of your grade) to give up time as needed. **By participating in this class, you agree to attend all Leadership Class sponsored events and activities – missing these due to other commitments and appointments is not an excuse. You will be graded for your participation in all events because applying to be in this class says that you will commit to attending all events. Taking family vacations, attending appointments, and participating in sports practices will not be excused absences and will affect your grade. You must schedule these events around your Leadership commitments. You will be presented with a calendar well in advance of the start of the school year.** If you are a person who has a hectic schedule before/after school, leadership would not be a good choice for you. If, however, you have time to dedicate to leadership, keep reading!

This class will be very interactive. We will be reading, doing cooperative activities, improving our leadership skills, and implementing what we have learned in schoolwide activities. We will also make class presentations, schoolwide presentations, and even statewide presentations (at the CASL State Leadership Conference held each Spring). Our number one goal in doing all of this is to help you to grow and develop as young leaders. This will help you to develop both as an individual, and as a productive member of a group.

The rewards of this group are amazing! You should develop personal Leadership skills, learn how to make large group presentations, and possibly even participate in regional, state, and national leadership conferences. Furthermore, you will learn the importance of community service within our school and larger community.

**All leadership students are also required to attend the summer leadership training event. This is an integral part of the teambuilding process, and therefore is a must.** We anticipate that the **dates for this mandatory event will be held in August – approximately one week before the start of school – exact dates will be published at the end of the school year. Students should plan to be there for the entire day/evening on those dates – these may involve weekday and/or weekend dates.
